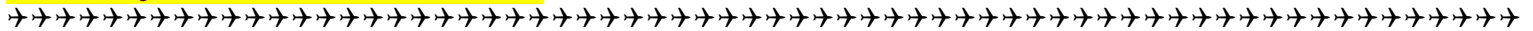

The United States has been selected to host the year 2011 F3A (Pattern) World Championships. They will be held at the AMA Headquarters site in Muncie IN. Specific dates to be scheduled.

Auction is January 29th

Hi all,

My name is Ryan Gross and I am a member of the Pine Barren Modelers (AMA 1727) in Barnegat. In January, our club is holding a flea market and auction (for the first time in many years) of r/c merchandise and related items. This event will begin with a flea market in which sellers can purchase table space for \$7 in advance or for \$10 at the door. Table prices also include the cost of admission. After two hours of a flea market, we will hold a fast-moving auction for those that wish to sell any merchandise in this manner. The auction will last for two hours and will run later if needed. The club **will not** take a commission on auctioned items; all monies go to the seller. General admission is \$2/head and all children under 12 are admitted free of charge. There will be a selection of food and beverages for purchase as well (Fruit, Hot Dogs, Snacks, Coffee, Soda, Juice, etc). I have attached a flier for the event to this email. It contains further details about the flea market/auction. I have also attached directions to the event site. I recommend using these directions in addition to a GPS as there have been considerable changes in the West Bay Avenue/Parkway interchange in Barnegat in the last year. The center, however, is still very easy to get to. I would appreciate you distributing (by email, print, or word of mouth) this information to your membership. One more thing...I neglected to include the date for the flea market in the body of my email. The date for the auction is January 29th. Table setup will begin at 8am with doors opening at 10am. The flea market goes until 2pm at which time the auction begins.

**Directions to the Pine Barren Modelers Flea Market and Auction @ the Barnegat Recreation Center
900 West Bay Avenue, Barnegat, NJ 08005**

From the West via Route 38:

- 1- Head east on **NJ-38**. Continue onto **County Rd 530 E/S Pemberton Rd**. 2- Turn right at **Magnolia Rd**. Continue east on **Magnolia Road** for approx. 4 miles until you reach the circle.
- 3- At the traffic circle, take the **2nd exit onto NJ-72 E**.
- 4- Continue on **72 E** for 16.5 miles then turn left at **Old Cedar Bridge Rd**. You will see a green sign pointing towards Barnegat. Immediately veer right and you are now on **County Rd 554E /West Bay Avenue**.
- 5- Follow **554 E** for 5 miles. You will go through 5 traffic lights on your way into Barnegat. Approx 300 feet past the 5th light is the left turn for the Barnegat Municipal Complex. Follow signs towards parking lots.

From the West via Route 70:

- 1-Take **NJ-70 E** for 18.5 miles towards the traffic circle. At the circle take the 1st exit onto **NJ-72 E**.
- 2- Continue on **72 E** for 16.5 miles then turn left at **Old Cedar Bridge Rd**. You will see a green sign pointing towards Barnegat.
- 3- Immediately veer right onto **County Rd 554E /West Bay Avenue**.
- 4- Follow **554 E** for 5 miles. You will go through 5 traffic lights on your way into Barnegat. Approx 300 feet past the 5th light is the left turn for the Barnegat Municipal Complex. Follow signs towards parking lots.

From the North:

- 1- Head south on the **Garden State Parkway**.
- 2- Take exit 67 toward the **Lighthouse Drive traffic light**. Veer right at the traffic light onto **Lighthouse Drive**.
- 3- After 2000 feet you will come to the intersection of **Lighthouse Dr and County Rd 554E/ West Bay Avenue** (There will be a super Wawa on your right). Turn right onto **554 E**.
- 4- You will pass through 2 more traffic lights. Approx 300 feet after the second light, turn left into the Barnegat Municipal Complex. Signs will direct you to parking in the rear of the complex.

From the South:

- 1- Take the **Garden State Parkway north** to Exit 67- Barnegat Township.
- 2- At the traffic light on the exit ramp, turn right onto **County Rd 554/West Bay Avenue**.
- 3- Go straight through 1 more light then approx. 300 feet later make the left into the Barnegat Municipal Complex. Signs will direct you to parking in the rear of the complex.
